







Interoperability process standards - DR interaction with SP-System





PRS.DR.01: 1 Registration in a benefits scheme for persons with disability






PRS.DR.02: Registration/intake in a benefits scheme for households/families member(s) with disability

Data Standards

Interoperability – Data Standards

DO.DR.01 PWDPerson

The **Person With Disability (PWDPerson)** data object is designed to provide essential information about persons with disabilities, which may be requested by social protection systems from disability systems.

- Personal Details: Basic identifying information of the person, such as name, age, gender, and contact information.
- **Disability Support requirement:** Information about the support required by the individual to overcome their functional difficulties and barriers they face for daily living and participation in society.
- Specific Disability Information: Details regarding the disability status of the persons as well as as type and level of impairment/functional limitations depending on the information that is recorded in the disability registry





API Standards

Interoperability – APIs Examples

Disabled Registry Sample API

Process Flow 1: SP-System queries the DR to request individuals with a specific disability criteria

Process Flow 2 : SP-System queries the DR to confirm disability status

► Process Flow 3 : Eligibility check in a Grants for Old Age Scheme enrollment

Process Flow 4: Register for persons with disability notifications with status approved


